S (I am in the direct seat, so partner has a bid coming, but I'm not defending against 2H. 2S is a reverse showing 17+ points, so it's 3D or pass. I'm not passing. 3D should show 4 diamonds and 15 points. I'm close.)

N 4NT (Key cards, 1430. Very aggressive/risky bid)

S 5H (2 Key cards, no Queen of diamonds.)

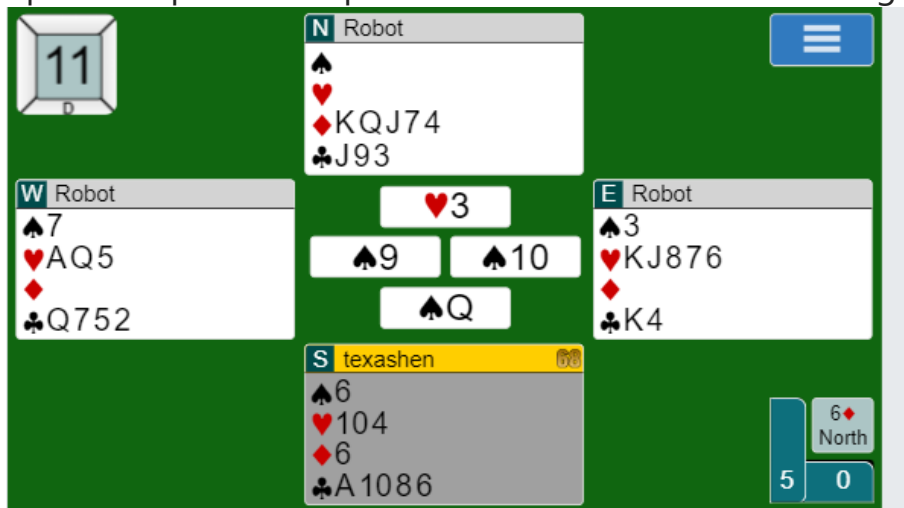
W DBL (Doubling an artificial bid calls for it to be led. West is demanding a heart lead)

N 6D

Passed out. I should go down when E/W take their AK of hearts. But I have a friend on lead and East leads the Jack of spades.



I pull trump and dump both of North's hearts on the high spades.



Now I play East for one of the club honors, which it has. So, I lost 1 club trick. Making 6. Sometimes defense isn't hard.
